About Our School

Fresno Adult School, the largest in Central California and the flagship for adult education in the San Joaquin Valley, offers each and every adult in our community and surrounding areas an opportunity to engage in life-long learning.

We offer a wide array of courses and programs for the adults in our community. Students at Fresno Adult School are challenged and grow academically with the focus on transitioning to the workplace or post-secondary education.

Our high school credit recovery classes are A-G approved (for entry into California State University and University of California campuses). The CTE, CNA and LVN programs have a passage rate in the 90th percentile. Our Adult Transition Program (ATP) provides support to students seeking higher education options by working with our local community college partners. Finally, over 1,700 Fresno Unified parents take our ESL classes to improve their language skills that enable them to help their students.

In 2017-18, Fresno Adult School enrolled 6,855 students. Of those, 277 received a high school diploma, 354 declared entry into employment, and 1,972 received career services. An additional 1,967 received transition services, and 347 declared transition to post-secondary institutions.
