The State Center Adult Education Consortium consists of adult schools, community colleges, and other local partners that provide basic education and short-term career technical education training for adults 18 years and older in order to assist with seamless transitions into the workforce and/or post-secondary education.

The region served is located within the Central San Joaquin Valley and includes Fresno and Madera counties and borders portions of Kings and Tulare counties. This area has a total population of 1,050,924, with a diverse population of 78 different nationalities. The diversity is evidenced by over 22% of the population being foreign born and over 44% of households speaking a language other than English.

The three main goals of the consortium are 1) to ensure that adults have access to services; 2) to increase system effectiveness and quality; 3) to prepare students for success in their next steps in college and further training, at work, and in the community. State Center Adult Education Consortium member schools, community colleges and local partners help approximately 15,000 students annually achieve their educational or employment goals.

The State Center Adult Education Consortium currently has twenty (20) members including fourteen (14) adult schools, three (3) community college campuses with two additional college centers, Fresno County Office of Education and Valley ROP.

Central Mother Lode Regional Consortium



The Central/Mother Lode Regional Consortium (CRC) serves as a liaison for the California Community Colleges Chancellors Office to advance the implementation of the **Doing What Matters/Strong Workforce Program within the region**. The CRC is a collaboration of 14 community colleges supporting regional economic growth & student success by improving CTE

offerings at community colleges to meet the needs of local industries; and serving as a connection between local colleges and businesses to develop a skilled workforce.

Doing What Matters Framework/Strong Workforce Program Goals – Facilitating efforts to help close the skills gap, responding to labor market demands and strengthen CTE by INCREASING the amount of CTE instruction offered; IMPROVING CTE outcomes; ALIGNING sector strategies, career pathways, regional partnerships and workforce development systems; and closing the EQUITY gaps in program access, completion, and earnings of underserved demographic populations.

The CRC has three priority sectors (Manufacturing, Health & Ag, Water & the Environment) and four Emerging sectors (Global Trade, ICT/Digital Media, Retail/Hospitality/Tourism, and small business) and three Technical Assistance providers –COE (labor market data/industry research), K-12 Pathways/SB1070 and Prop 39 (housed at host colleges, but are charged with serving the entire region).
